Qualifying settings

It is not allowed to change the amount of fuel manually before or during the Qualifying. The amount of fuel can only be adjusted by a regular pitstop. This means, the amount of fuel can only be raised, not decreased (only through driving).

During the Qualifying a regular pitstop with refueling and/or tyre change is allowed at anytime.

Start settings

The teams can define their own settings for the first stint. The settings must be given to the center manager latest directly after the **qualifying in written form**. Your CenterManager will hand-out a form to the teams latest during the briefing.

Settings are:

- Amount of fuel in liter
- Tyre type (Hard; Medium; Soft)
- Tyre pressure (front left, front right, rear left, rear right) in psi

The settings will be made by your CenterManager before the race start

Pitstop strategy

- The pitstop-strategy is free for all teams.
- For teams that require help, your center manager will help you with a standard pitstop strategy or the center manager can show you different possibilities on request.
- When a driver change is performed, the tires have to be changed and vice-versa.

Pitstop strategy settings

- In Centers where the RaceEngineer Pitstand is available, the settings for the next pitstop can be done by the teams themselves via the tablet. The CenterManager will explain the function during your practice session.
- In Centers with no RaceEngineer Pitstand, the settings will be made by the CenterManager via the keyboard. Please let the CenterManager know early enough which settings you like to have.

Rules:

1. Be gentle on the track with other drivers. Avoid dive bombs, no change of line if another car is very close or at your side.
2. Use the "Helix" to see where your competitor is located. If the Helix is yellow or red, no change of the line is allowed.
3. The use of the keyboard is not allowed. All necessary settings are made by the CenterManager before the sessions starts.
4. Blue flag: If you have a blue flag on the monitor or your dash-display blinks in blue, you have to let pass the car behind you.

Other rules and helps to avoid mistakes are explained in a separate document.

Pitstops:

1. Put the headset to the top of the seat (normal position), get slowly out of the simulator.
The new driver can put a towel to the seat, get into the simulator slowly, wear the headset and wait until the pitstop time is gone. There's no need to hurry, the pitstop is long enough for a gentle driver change. Refueling, tires change, and repair are done automatically.
 2. Pitstop in practice & qualifying
In order not to refuel, just park the car in the pitlane, not in the pitplace. You can drive through other cars standing in the pitlane.

Stream

The stream can be delayed by some seconds to the live event. The stream start with the practice session

General Conditions:

Cancellation fees:

Cancellation of Bookings by the Customer shall be made in writing to the respective Center where the Booking has been made. Each Center shall charge cancellation fees as compensation according to the following principles:

- *Cancellation with 48 hours' notice or less before the start date of the Event or with no-show: 100% of the price of the cancelled booking.*
- *Cancellation with 72 hours or more prior to the start date of the Event: 50% of the price of the cancelled booking.*
- *Shifting of a Booking qualifies as a cancellation and a new Booking.*
